YELLOWKNIFE. 26 February 2007. DDC owned Denendeh Investments Inc. announced that a new partnership has been formed under the name of Mackenzie Environmental Solutions LP. Darrell Beaulieu, President and CEO of DDC Group of Companies has been appointed President of Mackenzie Environmental Solutions Inc. (Mackenzie). Other board members are Don Balsillie, James Antoine and Roman Bittman.

“Our focus will be to utilize innovative and new technologies for contaminants primarily in the Mackenzie Basin area”, said Mr. Beaulieu. “Our first enterprise is as an exclusive Distributor and Sales Representation agreement with ENPAR Technologies Inc.”

Under this agreement, Mackenzie has been granted the rights to market, sell and utilize ENPAR’s state-of-the-art electrochemical technologies for treating ammonia (AmmEL System), arsenic and metals (DesEL System) and nitrate (NitrEL System). Applications include municipal waste water, mine water and other industrial waste waters, as well as drinking water. The area of coverage encompasses the NWT, Nunavut, Yukon and those areas of the Mackenzie River Watershed in northern sections of BC, Alberta and Saskatchewan. Mr. Beaulieu further added that Mackenzie is hoping that Aboriginal and other governments, industry and companies that are involved in environmental clean up will take an interest in our new water remediation technologies and utilize them in their clean up activities.

Dr. Gene Shelp, President and CEO of Enpar Technologies Inc said “We are very happy to be working with Mackenzie Environmental Solutions Inc. and to be applying our technologies to environmental remediation in the Mackenzie Basin area. We are introducing a DesEL Technology, a proven alternative to conventional water treatment systems for removing both dissolved contaminants such as arsenic, mercury and nitrate, and other dissolved ions from industrial waste water, process water and drinking water sources. As a home product, the DesEL System would replace both the reverse osmosis unit and the water softener”.

Jim Antoine commented “As a Dene from the north, we are stewards of our land and we would like to keep our lands as close to pristine as possible. We have been looking for effective environmental technologies that can take polluted waters and bring them back to as close to the pure natural state as possible.
